1ST Reading: Genesis 11: 1-9 *It was named Babel because there the language of the whole earth was confused.*
Acts 2: 1-11 *They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak.*

Psalm: 104: 1-2, 24, 35, 27-30 *Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.*

2ND Reading: Romans 8: 22-27 *The Spirit himself expresses our plea in a way that could never be put into words.*
Corinthians 12: 3-7, 12-13 *In the one Spirit we were all baptised.*

Gospel: John 7: 37-39 *From his breast shall flow fountains of living water.*

John 20: 19-23 *As the Father sent me, so am I sending you: receive the Holy Spirit.*

Reflection

In the prophecy of Joel, God declares: "I will pour out My Spirit on all people." For the people of that time, this message was extraordinary. Many believed that the presence of God was reserved only for those considered holy or righteous. Yet God revealed that His Spirit would be given not merely to a select few, but to ALL people.

This promise reached its fulfilment through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Through His sacrifice on the Cross, Christ paid the ultimate price for our sins and made us worthy to be called sons and daughters of God, gifting us His Spirit. Not only that, but Jesus has also made us temples of the Holy Spirit.

When did this reality first come to pass? **At Pentecost.**

On the day of Pentecost, the disciples were gathered together in fear, praying and waiting in the upper room. Suddenly, a mighty wind filled the house, and tongues of fire descended upon them. They were filled with the Holy Spirit, and their lives were completely transformed (*Acts 2*). The disciples themselves were ordinary and imperfect people. Those who were once afraid became bold witnesses for Christ. They went forth with courage, preaching the Good News, healing the sick, casting out demons, and bringing hope to the world. This was the power of the Holy Spirit working through them.

The message of Pentecost remains deeply relevant today. In a world where many strive to appear strong, righteous, or without weakness, the Holy Spirit reminds us that holiness is not achieved solely through human effort. Rather, it is God who works within us, renewing our hearts and guiding us toward a life of faith and holiness.

Today, that same Holy Spirit is still moving within us through our Baptism. In our weakness, fear, and struggles, the Holy Spirit comes to strengthen us, guide us, and remind us that we are never alone. He fills our hearts with God's love and leads us closer to holiness.

On this Day of Pentecost, let us open our hearts and pray: "Come, Holy Spirit. Fill me with Your presence. Remove my fear, renew my faith, and set my heart on fire for Jesus. May the fire of the Holy Spirit renew our lives and help us become faithful disciples of Christ."

Pentecost is not merely a historical event; it is the continuing reality of God's presence among His people!

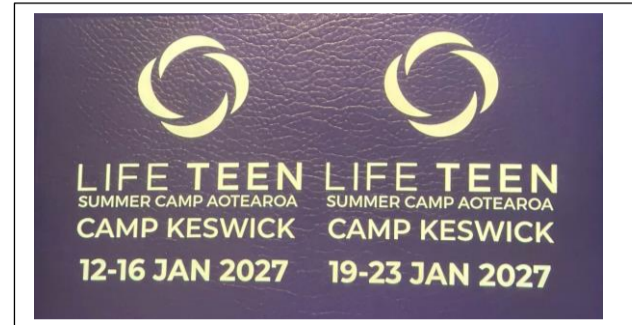
