St Mark's Mission Statement

To promote a loving, caring, Christlike Community which accepts all people. And inspired by the Holy Spirit to spread the good news of Jesus Christ.

1ST Reading: Eccl. 27: 30-28: 7 *Forgive your neighbour the hurt he does you, and when you pray, your sins will be forgiven.*

Psalm: 102: 1-4. 9-12 *The Lord is compassion and love, slow to anger and rich in mercy.*

2ND Reading: Romans 14: 7-9 *Alive or dead we belong to the Lord.*

Gospel: Matthew 18: 21-35 *I do not tell you to forgive seven time, but seventy-seven times.*

Reflection

Forgiveness is not forgetting the hurt, it is choosing not to let the hurt have the final word.

Today's readings remind us of the importance of forgiveness, mercy, and letting go of anger. We are reminded that we all make mistakes and need God's forgiveness. If we ask God to forgive us, we are also called to show that same mercy to others.

In today's Gospel, Peter asks Jesus a question that many of us can relate to: "Lord, how often should I forgive?" Peter thinks he is being generous by suggesting seven times. But Jesus responds, "Not seven times, but seventy-seven times." Jesus is not asking us to keep a record of how many times we forgive. He is teaching us that forgiveness should not have a limit.

For example, imagine that someone close to you says something hurtful. You may forgive them once, but then they hurt you again. You might think, "I've forgiven them so many times already. Why should I keep forgiving?" This is where Jesus challenges us. Forgiveness does not mean allowing someone to continually hurt us, rather forgiveness means refusing to carry the bitterness.

Sometimes forgiveness is a process. We may still feel hurt even after deciding to forgive. But we can choose not to seek revenge. We can pray for the person. We can slowly release the anger and ask God to heal our hearts.

Perhaps today we can ask ourselves: Who is the person I am finding hardest to forgive? And can I ask God for the grace to begin letting go—not for their sake alone, but for the healing of my own heart?

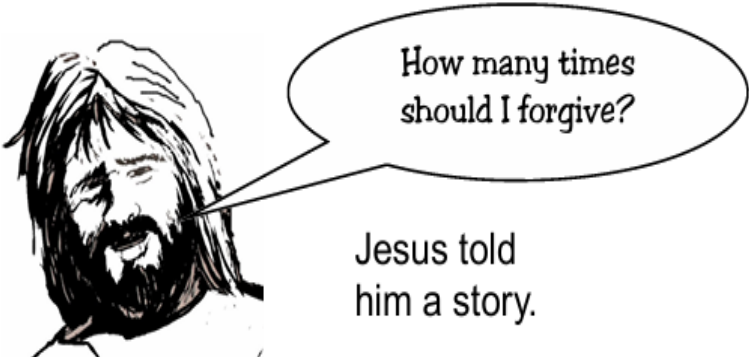
